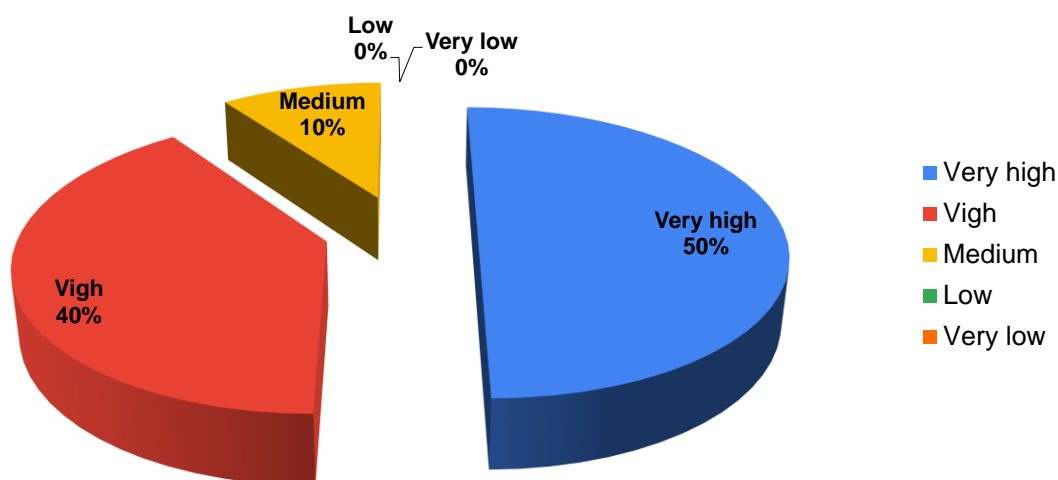

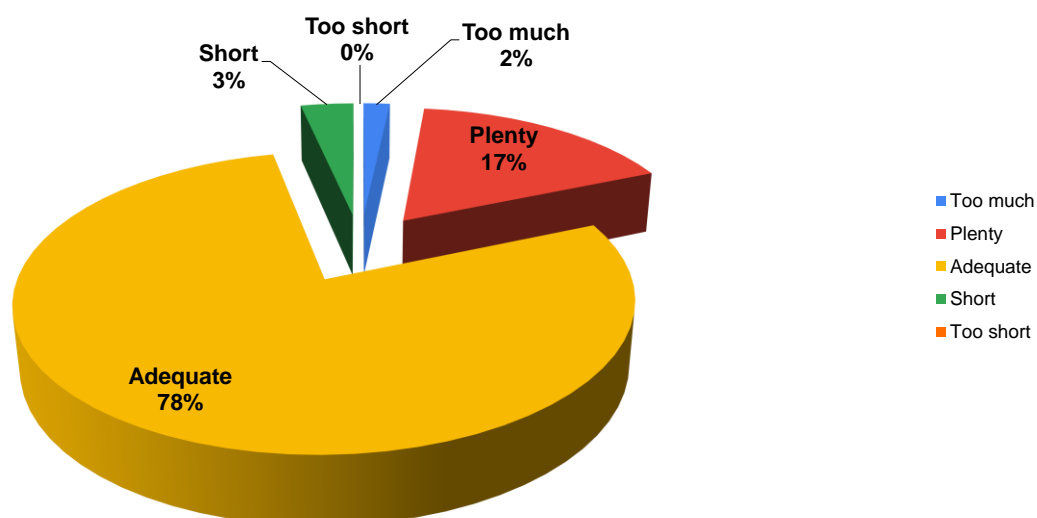

"2. Amount of time devoted to each topic"

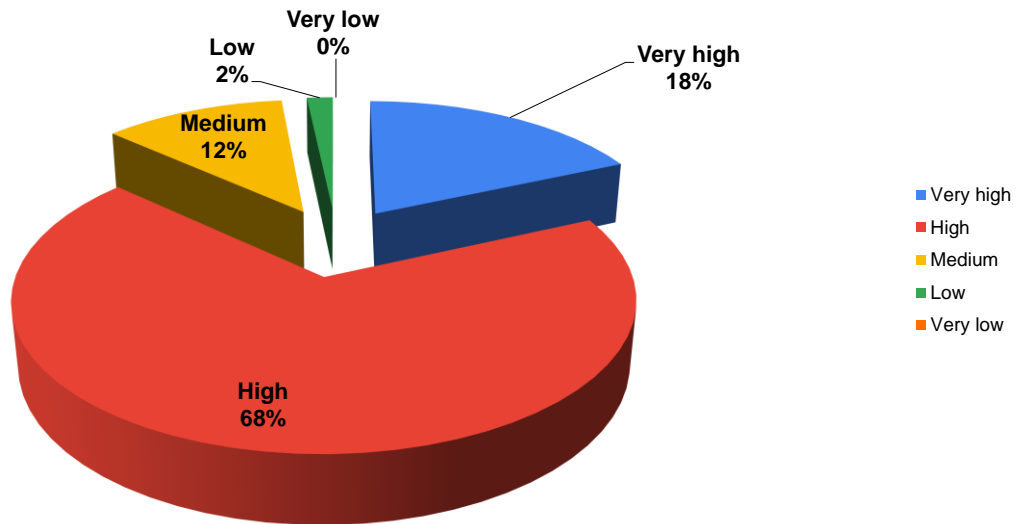
Amount of time devoted to each top (Likert scale: 1 = too short; 5: too much)





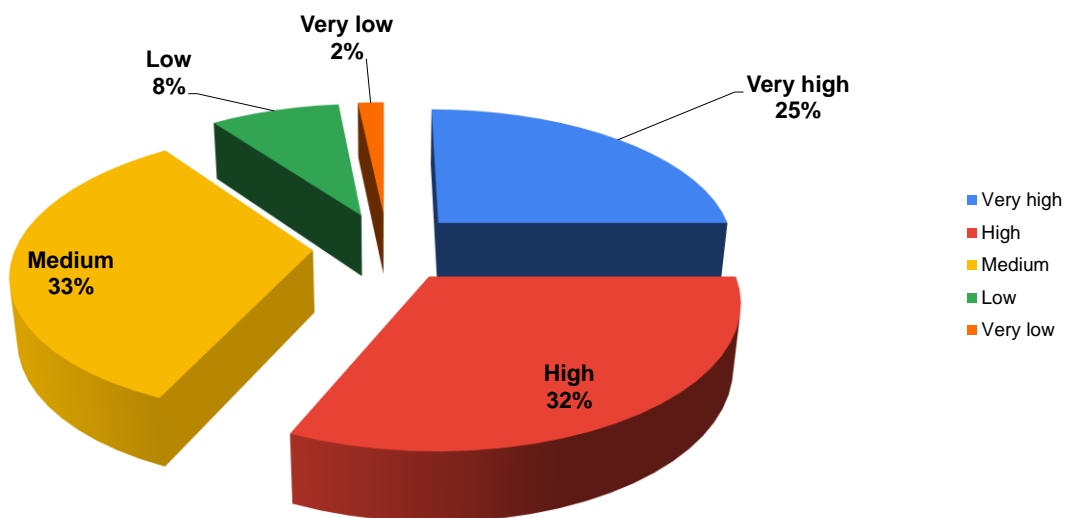
"3. Quality of lecturing"

"4. Applicability of topics to your personal work"

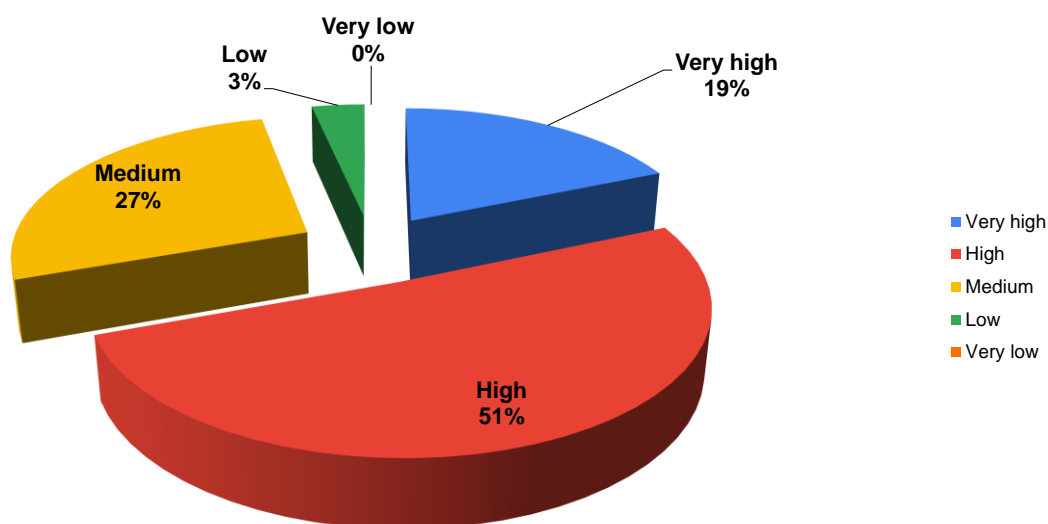
Applicability of topics to your personal work
(Likert scale: 1 = very low; 5: Very high)





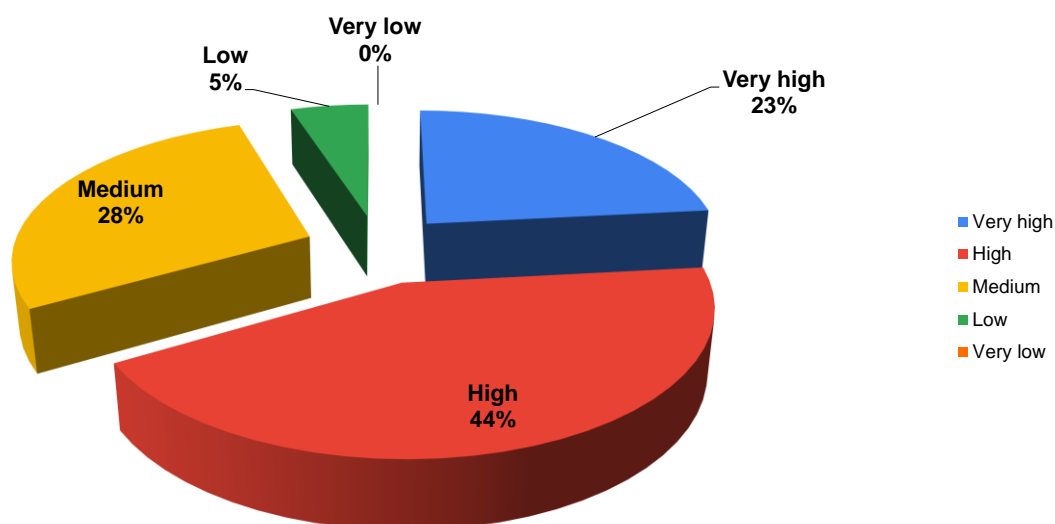
"5. Completeness and quality of the training material"

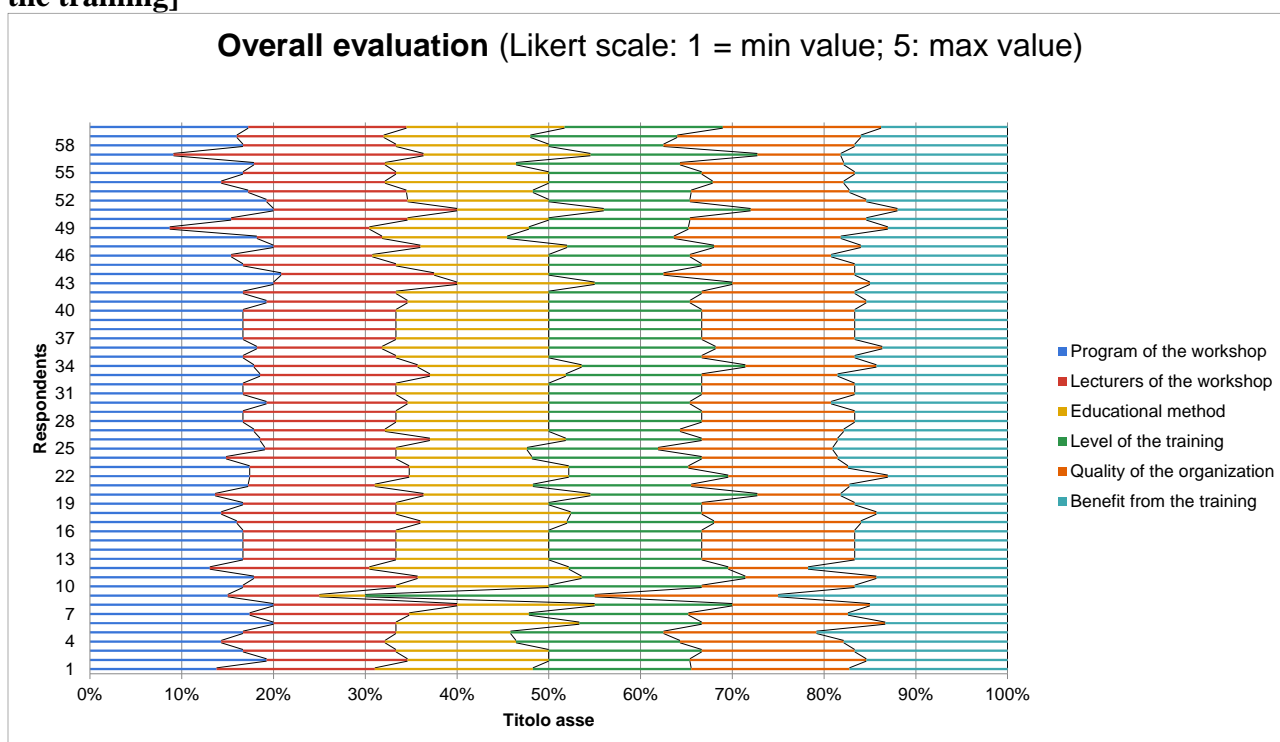
